Napoleon Seizes Power Napoleon Bonaparte was born in 1769 on the Mediterranean island of Corsica When he was nine years old, his parents sent him to a military school In 1785, at the age of 16, he finished school and became a lieutenant in the artillery When the Revolution broke out, Napoleon joined the army of the new government
